PLEASE NOTE: SUBMIT YOUR MILEAGE AND HOG NUMBER TO JASON AS CLOSE TO JANUARY 1 AS POSSIBLE TO GET THE YEAR STARTED!

Ride 365 is the Official Mileage Recognition Program for H.O.G., the official riding club of Harley-Davidson. Ride 365 includes Lifetime Recognition, Annual Recognition and an annual Chapter Challenge program that measures total chapter miles and average per-member miles. For the lifetime and annual programs, any H.O.G. member can participate. For the Chapter Challenge, if the member is listed as a chapter member in the H.O.G. system, their mileage readings will automatically be added to the chapter challenge. This should encourage our Intermountain H.O.G. members to focus on the reason we own H-D motorcycles—to ride them!

Complete the attached **RIDE 365 Form** and take it to High Desert Harley-Davidson and see Jason or Jeremy anytime Tuesday through Thursday to get your mileage verified. David W Kesner (aka Dr. Dave), Member at Large

I was born October 21, 1956 at Hamilton AFB, California and raised in a military family. We moved every few years living all over the US and in France, Japan, and Okinawa. At 17 I graduated high school and had my parents sign the papers for me to join the Air Force. I was trained as a Medical Lab Technician.

When I got out I came home to Idaho and got a job with the Idaho State Lab and worked my way up to a Cytogenetic Technologist. After 25

years the State closed the lab and I went to work under a joint venture between St. Luke's and St. Al's called the Idaho Cytogenetic Diagnostic Lab for the next 12 years until that also closed down. My last few years before I retired this year were spent at Materials Testing and Inspection working in the environmental lab doing asbestos testing.



My first Harley was a 1979 FXEF Fat Bob that I bought new from Cycle Nuts and Bolts in Garden City. Then came a 1977 Electra Glide, a 1984 Softail, a 2018 Road King, and I currently ride a 2020 Road Glide Limited. I also still have the 84 Softail and have put over 200,000 miles on it. At least 3/4 of all the miles I have put on motorcycles was done with my wife Peggy on the back. Sadly, she passed away just over three years ago. I have had to learn to adjust my riding style without her. Can't say that I miss the slaps upside my helmet when I wasn't riding like she wanted though.

When I bought the 84 Softail I received a one year membership in the national HOG organization. Later that year I joined the local chapter which was known as IDAHOG. A few years later national made us change our name to Intermountain HOG. A few years later I became a life member. My membership number is 54370, quite something when I see all these numbers in the millions now. I took some time off from the group when my wife and I had our only son Talon, but have been back for quite some time now.

Like most Idahoans I enjoy most every outdoor activity - hunting, fishing, camping, ATV riding, etc. I also became very active in caving to the point where I was teaching caving and rappelling at BSU, did several TV shows with Outdoor Idaho and the local news stations, and became a Fellow of the National Speleological Society for my cave conservation work. I am also very passionate about photography, especially 3D or Stereo Photography. At least once or twice a year I will do a photo shoot for the group making

frameable prints available.

Now that I am single, retired, have my house paid off, and no other bills I have the time and money to go riding just about whenever and wherever I want. 
We have been chapter members since 2016 and have come to thoroughly enjoy and look forward to every part of it, especially the rides.

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

By becoming a Life Flight Network Member, you agree to the terms stated below.

A Life Flight Network Membership relieves you from liability for out-of-pocket costs of emergent, medically necessary transports completed and billed by Life Flight Network. Your membership is not an insurance policy but secondary to insurance carriers and health care cost sharing programs. All available insurances will be billed first including health, auto, workers compensation and third-party insurance. Life Flight Network will accept payment from insurance carriers and other third party payers as payment in full.

Membership benefits are available for those eligible household members listed on the member record at the time of transport if the transport is an emergent, medically necessary transport to the closest, most appropriate facility, performed by Life Flight Network, its contracted agents, or reciprocal partners, subject to the reciprocal program's rules.

Membership benefits are extended to the primary member, his/her spouse or domestic partner and dependents claimed on their income tax return. Dependents must be added to the member record within 30 days of birth or adoption. Elderly (age 65+) and disabled family members living in the same household are also covered. Life Flight Network may require documentation or other verification of membership eligibility.

Emergency medical transports are based on medical need, not membership status. Medical need can only be determined by a physician, EMS provider, hospital or another qualified third-party recognized by Medicare, and is in all cases subject to the final determination of the health insurance carrier, if any. Non-emergent transports are not eligible for Life Flight Network membership benefits.

Availability of service cannot be guaranteed due to weather conditions, maintenance, commitment to another transport, out-of-service equipment and other reasons.

New and lapsed membership benefits take effect 72 hours after receipt of a completed enrollment with payment.

Membership fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and are not tax-deductible. Life Flight Network may cease selling and servicing memberships should any governmental body, now or in the future, determine memberships can no longer be offered within their jurisdiction. No refunds will be made for any memberships already purchased.

I transfer directly to Life Flight Network my rights to insurance payments due to me for services provided by Life Flight Network. Such payments shall not exceed Life Flight Network's regular charges. Denial of a claim by an insurance provider must be received by Life Flight Network in writing. Membership benefits do not extend to transports deemed not medically necessary or when insurers deny payments due to coordination of benefit issues. Per government regulations, individuals covered by Medicaid are not eligible for Life Flight Network membership and should not apply.

I specifically release and waive any and all rights, claims or causes of action against Life Flight Network and its employees and agents with respect to my Life Flight Network Membership.
